Postering over another candidate campaigning lit.	\$5/\$10 posters	n/a	2-4
*Misuse of an elected or appointed position	\$5/\$10 posters	Disqualification	2-15
Unauthorized handbill distribution	\$5/\$10 posters	\$50/50 posters	4-5
Postering in a restricted area	\$5/\$10 posters	\$50/100 posters	4-5
*Unauthorized campaigning	\$10/\$20 posters	Campaign suspension	6-15
*Unsolicited Emails	\$15/\$20 posters	\$50/50 posters	6-10
Campaigning outside/ off-campus / unauthorized areas	\$5/\$10 posters	\$50/100 posters	6-8
*Pre-Campaigning	\$15/\$30 posters	Disqualification	8-15
*Negative Campaigning	\$20/\$20 posters	Disqualification	8-15
Inhibiting other Candidates	\$20/\$20 posters	Disqualification	8-11
*Engaging External Support	\$50/\$50 posters	Disqualification	12-15
Spending over given budget	Campaign suspension	Disqualification	12-15

Action of Elections SSMU:

- 12 Demerits - Public Announcement.
- 8 Demerits - Issuing a formal warning to Campaign Committee in questions
- 15-20 Demerits - Automatic consideration of disqualification/invalidation and calling of the ERC. Written ruling by Elections SSMU.
